POSITION: Foundation Level Intern (Graduate)

Master's in Social Work Students

DESCRIPTION: Intern will provide support to MOCSA through the 24-hour crisis line, hospital and

police advocacy, youth education, and observing and assisting with skills groups.

DUTIES: Intern will provide crisis intervention, advocacy, information, resources, referrals,

and problem solving to individuals calling the 24-hour crisis line.

Intern will respond to Kansas City Metro Area hospitals and law enforcement

jurisdictions to provide advocacy.

Intern will provide child sexual abuse prevention education to pre-kindergarten

through fifth grade.

Intern will provide prevention education to middle and high school students for

the purpose of preventing sexual assault.

Intern will work as assistant to Partners in Healing facilitator. Partners in Healing

is a group for families who have experienced sexual abuse.

Intern will provide assistance and support in preparing for legislative activities

and sexual assault awareness month.

Intern will assist with observation and facilitation of skills groups. Intern may

facilitate a skills group the second semester of their internship.

Additional opportunities may include: program development projects, community

outreach and networking, macro advocacy projects and additional assistance for

agency programs as qualifications allow.

TRAINING: Intern will complete a 40-hour sexual violence training prior to beginning

placement. Trainings are offered 3 times annually.

Intern will shadow staff members and attend appropriate in-services or staff

trainings.

DESCRIPTION: Intern will provide support to MOCSA through the 24-hour crisis line, hospital and

police advocacy, and counseling services to sexual assault survivors, child and adult survivors of sexual abuse and their significant others. May assist with

facilitation of groups.

DUTIES: Intern will provide crisis intervention, advocacy, information, resources, referrals,

and problem solving to individuals calling the 24-hour crisis line.

Intern will respond to Kansas City Metro Area hospitals and law enforcement

jurisdictions to provide advocacy.

Intern will observe and co-facilitate skills and process groups.

Intern will provide counseling sessions to sexual assault survivors, child and

adult survivors of sexual abuse, and significant others.

Intern may observe and co-facilitate sex offender treatment group

QUALIFICATIONS: Intern must be currently enrolled in a graduate program.

Interns who have experienced sexual abuse or assault must wait two years after an incident of assault has occurred and/or one year after completing treatment.

TRAINING: Intern will complete 40-hour sexual violence training prior to beginning

placement. Trainings are offered 3 times annually.

Intern will have the opportunity to attend numerous internal and external

trainings.
