## **Position Description Education Intern – Project Aware**

This unpaid internship opportunity is available August 2017 – May 2018, with a minimum commitment of one semester. Education interns will provide pre-scripted Project Aware presentations to children pre-K to 6th grade in Jackson, Platte, Clay, and Cass Counties in Missouri and Johnson and Wyandotte Counties in Kansas. Project Aware educates students about body safety and teaches adults their role in preventing sexual abuse. This opportunity is open to all majors of study and recommended for students in Education, Public Health, Social Work, Counseling, and Communications.

### **Internship Requirements & Responsibilities:**

- A minimum of 10 hours per week during business hours.
- Thursday afternoons 2pm – 5pm required.
- Facilitate Project Aware classroom presentations, distribute materials, and post-test.
- Data recording and entry.
- Represent MOCSA at daytime community events.
- Attend a supervisory meeting for at least 1 hour per week; completing supervision form prior to the meeting.

### **Qualifications:**

- Comfort and/or experience with public speaking in a classroom setting.
- Comfort and/or experience working with children pre-K to 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- A basic understanding of or interest in the field of sexual abuse and assault.
- Must have a driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle.
- Clear criminal and child abuse background screen.
- Strong interpersonal and problem solving skills.

### Internship Benefits:

- Education Interns will have the opportunity to gain experience and knowledge with the classroom, nonprofit environment, and the greater community.
- Training and professional development opportunities including MOCSA's 40 hour training, weekly supervision, and continuing education workshops.
- Classroom hours may be counted towards licensure.
- Mileage reimbursement, modern office environment, and networking opportunities.

### Physical Demands:

- Frequently moves audio/visual equipment weighing up to 25 pounds for various classrooms and events.
- Must be able to remain in both standing and stationary positions for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to operate a computer and other office machinery (i.e., copy machine, and computer printer).
