## Metropolitan Organization to Counter Sexual Assault

Dear Internship Supervisors, Liaisons, and Students:

MOCSA works with individuals across the lifespan who have experienced sexual abuse and/or assault. We offer a number of exciting opportunities for undergraduate-level internships! We provide interns with in-depth training, weekly supervision, and opportunities for continuing education. Interns will also participate in a variety of activities depending on their internship requirements, including direct service, crisis intervention, and community education, among many others.

The following is a list of mandatory expectations for interns at MOCSA:

- Complete a 40 hour training addressing key elements of crisis intervention with sexual assault survivors. This is a mandatory training that all staff, volunteers, and interns must complete. This learning opportunity will provide interns with skills that they can carry forward in their careers.
- Meet weekly for individual supervision with a staff member serving as their field supervisor.
- Participate in team meetings on Thursday afternoons between the hours of 3-5 PM. During these meetings we discuss crisis line coverage, agency updates, questions, and concerns.
- Work one 4.25 hour crisis line shift weekly, either from 8:30 AM to 12:45 PM or from 12:45 PM to 5:00 PM. The Volunteer Program Coordinator will work with interns to assign weekly shifts based on the intern's availability and the agency's needs. Working on the crisis line often also involves providing hospital and law enforcement advocacy. Interns must have access to transportation.
