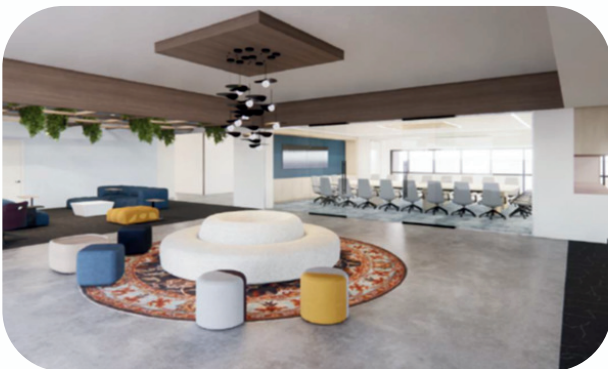
MOCSA's new home will provide us with more space to continue serving our community, while also offering an accessible, survivor-centric, and trauma-informed space.

Building - \$5,000,000 A welcoming and safe space that reflects MOCSA's strong commitment to survivors. A place built for healing and collaboration.

Welcome Plaza \$1,000,000 Main entry to MOCSA building; offers an inviting and warm first impression, surrounded by natural elements and purposeful pops of color.

Welcome Reception Center \$1,000,000 A warm and peaceful space with natural elements. Includes waiting area for survivors with a beverage station and a small private waiting room for those preferring more privacy, and established children's area.

Collaboration Atrium \$1,000,000 An open interior space with modern feel and relaxing seating areas to encourage partnership and collaboration amongst MOCSA's staff and volunteers.

Community Training Center \$500,000 A large, flexible educational space to provide training in best practices for responding to and preventing sexual violence to MOCSA's agency partners, community groups, and volunteers.

Rooftop Reflection Garden \$500,000 A unique outdoor space for staff and volunteers to take a break from the stress of their work and enjoy a peaceful place for reflection and rejuvenation. It will also serve as a space for community events. It includes plants, green space, art, and portable furniture for a variety of uses.

MOCSA History Display \$250,000 A singular historical display of MOCSA's important touchpoints over the last 50 years, including important aspects of the organization's evolution, culture, and community partners. Located at the entry of the large training center where hundreds of guests will visit annually.

Meditation Garden \$250,000 A restorative outdoor garden space surrounded by the healing power of nature. Designed for small group therapy sessions, team meetings and individual use.

Integrative Health/Yoga Room \$250,000 A comforting room for the healing practice of yoga, meditation, and other integrative health services to support the healing journey.

Board Room \$150,000 A functional, and comfortable meeting space for MOCSA leadership; includes technology for virtual and in-person meetings.

Group Therapy Room (2 available) \$100,000 Healing spaces for group therapy; provides warmth, confidentiality and various seating options and flexibility for room configuration.

Play and Art Therapy Room (2 available) \$100,000 A space that encourages the effective power of healing through art and play therapy, for children and adults.

Sand Tray Room (2 available) \$75,000 Room for the expressive therapy that uses miniature toys and sand. Allows survivors to participate in guided activities with a certified therapist as part of their custom treatment plan.

Team Wellness Center \$50,000 A fully equipped gym for MOCSA staff to support their physical and mental wellness by reducing the impact of secondary trauma through physical activity.

Meeting Room (8 available) \$25,000 Meeting spaces for MOCSA staff to carry out important daily business, brainstorm and collaborate with coworkers, external partners, and volunteers.

Meditation Bench (4 available) \$10,000 A comfortable seat for survivors surrounded by seasonal plants to enhance their wellbeing while reflecting, processing, and unwinding.

Tree Plaque (4 available) \$5,000 A unique and lasting way to honor donors and/or memorialize special individuals within a natural setting on the MOCSA campus.
